



Teacher Training Development Grant

The Trustees of the Consortium are delighted to invite bids from former partner schools to apply for funding to support projects that further our object.

'The object of the Consortium is for the benefit of the public, the advancement of further and higher education, including in particular but without limitation the training of persons as teachers and associated development activities'.

Bids for funding of up to £10,000 are invited to support projects that improve the capacity of the school to engage in staff development with particular focus on Initial Teacher Training and the Early Career Framework.

Bids should be submitted electronically to arrive no later than 9:00 am on Monday 31 May 2021. They will be considered by the Trustees and successful schools will be notified by Friday 11 June.

In this first round of bidding the criteria is open, as is the bidding format. However, the bid **must** demonstrate:

- how the project supports the object of the Consortium;
- how the funding will support school development;
- how the funding is supporting additionality;
- who is managing the project at the school;
- who is likely to benefit from the funding;
- what the project activity specifically will be, including start and end dates;
- how the impact of the funding will be self-evaluated;
- how the school may have used funding from the Consortium to support teacher trainee development in the past.

Projects will be judged on the above criteria with a particular focus on innovation and additionality.

Successful bidders will be asked to submit their evaluation of the project once the project is completed.

The Consortium regrets that it will not be able to provide feedback on unsuccessful bids.
